Overview

Click on the "Student Accommodate Login" button on the left side of the <u>SDS</u> <u>homepage</u>. This will log you into the Accommodate system.

- 1. Once logged in, click on the "Accommodations" tab.
- 2. Then complete the Initial Request for Services form.

Registering with SDS

Students who wish to use disability-based access accommodations in classes or housing at UMBC must be **registered** with the Office of Student Disability Services (SDS). Students are encouraged to begin the SDS registration process early after admission to UMBC, before their placement testing date.

1. To begin your SDS registration process and to request disability-based accommodations, go to the <u>Student Disability Services Registration Form</u> online and complete all the required sections. Eligibility for disability services must be established before accommodations can be provided and implemented, i.e., showing that under the ADA, you are "a person with a disability who has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities."

You can upload a copy of your documentation of disability/diagnosis from an appropriately qualified provider at the bottom of the online request form. Alternatively, to submit documentation in another way, please see number 2 below.





- A window will open to allow you to select your document to upload if you have scanned your documentation
- 2. If you only have hard copies and cannot scan, please bring them to our office located in Math/Psych Rm. 212 and note this on your registration page





- Once you have filled out the SDS Registration Online Form and have attached your supporting documentation, please click the "Submit" button.
- After submitting your Initial Service Request form and documentation, you must schedule an initial appointment with SDS staff.
- Please note: The documentation review process can take up to two weeks.
